The Last Half Century of Chinese Overseas (1945–1994): Comparative Perspectives¹

The international migration system over the last 30 years has been totally transformed. Where international flows once were dominated by the movement of people leaving Europe to settle in North America and Australia, now the traditional countries of origin of migration in Europe are themselves destinations for migrants, and the regions of origin of migrants to North America and Australia have diversified. A significant and increasing component of this transformation is made up of Chinese people leaving Hong Kong, Taiwan, Singapore, Malaysia, and China itself. Migration out of China is, of course, not new, with some 12 million Chinese moving out of China from 1820 onwards primarily to the Nanyang or the countries of southeast
