## ISSCO Regional Conference, 2018:

*Chinese Diaspora and the Contemporary Rise of China:  
Migration, Settlement and Transnational Networks*

**The University of Melbourne, 25th-26th October, 2018**

The rapid rise of China as a major global, economic and political power in recent decades has transformed patterns of Chinese international migration, settlement and diaspora linkages. The effects of these changes are particularly apparent in the Pacific Rim region, including Australia, Canada, New Zealand, the United States, and Pacific Island nations.

The 2018 ISSCO conference seeks to explore and discuss the causes, processes, and consequences of Chinese migration from mainland China and other sources including re-migration from Southeast Asia and the rest of the world. While proposals that focus on Oceania and the Pacific Rim region are especially welcome, the convenors also encourage proposals that address contemporary issues relating to Chinese international migration, settlement and transnational networks in Asia, Europe, Africa and other parts of the world.

Suggested topics include, but are not limited to, the following:

- The impact of China's rise on the direction and composition of Chinese international migration
- Recent migration from Mainland China and China's bilateral relations with destination countries
- New Chinese migration and the globalisation of China's foreign investment and trade
- Comparative analysis of new and older cohorts of Chinese migration from different sources
- Changing patterns of Chinese migration including sources, numbers, and composition
- Settlement and adjustment of ethnic Chinese communities
- Impact of policy changes at the sending and receiving countries on Chinese international migration, adjustment and networks
- Return and circular migration
- Student migration
- Business, science and technology migration
- Comparative analysis of Chinese, Indian, Korean, and other diaspora groups



We welcome proposals from a variety of approaches, methodologies, and disciplines. Graduate students and early career academics are especially encouraged to participate. Please send abstracts of 200 to 300 words and a short biographical note including institutional affiliation (maximum 100 words) to [ISSCO-2018@unimelb.edu.au](mailto:ISSCO-2018@unimelb.edu.au) by 31 May 2018. If a Chinese abstract is provided, we would appreciate an English translation.

Proposals are welcomed for 20-minute papers as well as panels of 3 x 20 minutes papers. Proposals for complete panels should have contact details of all confirmed participants.

# 世界海外华人研究学会 (ISSCO) 2018研讨会

## “海外华人与当代中国崛起：移民、定居与跨国网络”

2018年10月25日-10月26日 · 墨尔本大学

世界海外华人研究学会 (ISSCO) 2018年研讨会的主题是：“海外华人与当代中国崛起：移民、定居与跨国网络”，现开始征集与本主题相关的论文提要。

中国经过近几十年的迅速发展，已经崛起为世界的一个主要政治、经济强国。这一事实改变了华人移民跨国流动、定居和社会网络的模式，其影响在太平洋周边地区（包括澳大利亚、加拿大、新西兰、美国和其他太平洋岛屿国家）表现得尤为明显。

本次研讨会旨在深入探讨中国大陆移民、东南亚及世界其他地区华人再移民的原因、过程及意义。

本次研讨会特别欢迎就大洋洲及环太平洋地区华人移民专题展开研讨，同时也欢迎就亚洲、欧洲、非洲及世界其他地区华人移民跨国流动、定居及跨国网络等专题展开研讨。

本次研讨会主要关注如下议题：

- 中国崛起对华人移民跨国流动方向及移民人口构成的影响
- 中国大陆新移民及中国与移民接收国的双边关系
- 华人新移民与中国对外投资、贸易的全球化
- 对不同来源地新、老华人移民群体的比较分析
- 华人移民来源地、数量及构成的变化模式
- 各地华人移民社群的定居与适应
- 来源国及接收国政策变化对华人移民跨国流动、定居适应及跨国网络的影响
- 移民回流与循环流动
- 学生迁移
- 商务和科技移民
- 华裔与印度裔、韩裔及其他移民族群的比较分析

我们诚邀来自不同学科、使用不同研究方法从不同角度研究华人问题的学者积极投稿本次研讨会，并特别鼓励研究生及青年学者投稿参与研讨。

# ISSCO Regional Conference in Nagasaki: Chinese Overseas: Global and Local Dynamics >>

The 11th ISSCO Regional Conference was held successfully at Nagasaki University on November 18-19. This conference was co-organized by ISSCO, Nagasaki University, China Institute for Chinese Overseas Studies, and Japan Society for the Study of Chinese Overseas, as well as co-sponsored by a number of local and international organizations.

Altogether more than 200 scholars from 18 countries in Asia, North America, Europe, Australia, South America, and Africa attended the conference and presented 178 papers in Chinese, English and Japanese.

At the brief opening ceremony, the former President of Nagasaki University Prof. Prof. Katamine Shigeru and ISSCO President Tan CB welcomed participants to the conference which was graced by the Governor of Nagasaki Prefecture Mr. Nakamura, the Mayor of Nagasaki City Mr. Taue, and the Chinese Consul General of the People's Republic of China in Nagasaki Ms. Liu Yaming. Following the opening ceremony, Prof. Takeshi Hamashita and Mr. Wang Lianmao (former Director of the Quanzhou Maritime Museum) delivered keynote speeches, in English and Chinese respectively. Prof. Hamashita delivered his speech on "Historical Geography of Migration Networks in Cross-China Seas:15-20 Centuries". The speech by Mr. Wang Lianmao on "The Cultural Roles of Overseas Migrants from Minnan, Fujian" was appropriately preceded by an excellent nanyin performance.

The main session topics included qiaoxiang study, Chinese in Japan, new immigrants, gender and literature, non-Han Chinese overseas, Chinese migrants and homeland, food and the study of the Chinese overseas.

The highlight of the conference was the Special Speech by Prof. Wang Gungwu in celebration of the 25th anniversary of ISSCO, which was delivered at the end of the conference. This was an excellent lecture that covered the breadth of history of the Chinese overseas and of China and the study of the Chinese overseas, all in 40 minutes. He began with the period when Chinese overseas was still not a serious topic of study to the present when all kinds of topics were studied. Each period had its challenges for both the Chinese overseas and the study of the Chinese overseas, all linked to the changing fate of China and global politics, such as the establishment of the Republic of China in 1911, the link of the Chinese overseas with Chinese nationalism, the civil wars that threatened to tear China apart, the Second World War, and following that, the formation of nation states and the shift of overseas Chinese from identifying with China to identifying with the local states, the Cold War when it was sensitive to study topics relating to China, the opening up of China, and nobody expected the 21st century rise of China. The future study of the Chinese overseas needs to take into consideration this rise of China. The next ISSCO conference in Melbourne will appropriately take up this important theme.

## 世界海外华人研究学会第11届区域大会在长崎召开 >>

世界海外华人研究学会 (ISSCO) 第11届区域大会以“海外华人：全球化与地方化的活力”为主题，于2017年11月18-19日在日本长崎大学成功地召开。大会由ISSCO、长崎大学、中国华侨华人研究所及日本华侨华人学会(JSSCO)共同主办，东华教育文化交流财团、长崎国际观光协会、长崎县政府、长崎历史文化博物馆、长崎中国交流史协会、长崎华侨总会、日本华人教授会、新加坡南洋理工大学南洋公共管理研究生院、华侨华人研究国际学报等在内的17家单位和团体作为协办和后援。来自北美、亚洲、欧洲、澳洲、南美、非洲等地18个国家的200余名学者出席了会议，共发表了178篇中、英、日文的研究报告。

开幕式上，长崎大学前校长片峰茂、ISSCO会长陈志明、长崎县知事村中法道、长崎市长田上富久、中国驻长崎总领事刘亚明、新加坡南洋理工大学南洋公共管理研究生院院长刘宏分别致辞。陈志明会长在欢迎致辞中契合大会主题，提及到ISSCO创立25年的历史以及长崎与福建缔结友好交流省县35周年的现状，指出学会研究队伍扩大的必要性，并期待更多有关非汉族华侨华人研究成果的诞生。新加坡南洋理工大学南洋公共管理研究生院院长刘宏指出了本次会议在长崎召开具有特别重要的意义：在历史上，长崎是日本华侨社会的发祥地，是东亚-东南亚贸易的重要港口，也是中日文化交流的重要平台。今日，长崎是当代华侨华人本土化与全球化结合的一个典范。滨下武志教授及泉州海外交通史博物馆前馆长王连茂分别作了主题报告。

滨下教授在以“15-20世纪环中国海移民网络的历史地理”为题的演讲中指出：

华侨华人研究有三个大的时空背景转换：1) 15-18世纪，以朝贡关系和朝贡贸易为背景的放射模式移民网络；2) 18-19世纪，伴随着民族国家与民族主义抬头而凝聚的国民性与民族性；3) 20-21世纪，以全球化为背景，形成了周缘型无中心网络、沿海都市网络以及由移民网路所构成的公共空间。在此时空大背景下，滨下教授具体分析了长崎、九州与环中国海贸易网络中的华侨华人的历史意义，并提出了全球化中的多区域认同概念，指出以长期历史与大历史的眼光，从包括自然环境、灾害、地方社会、人类史与自然科学等在内的整体和综合视点来审视海域与陆域关系的重要性。在结论中，滨下教授提供了多种不同的网络模型，同时提示了汉萨同盟那样的社会经济型都市间网络的启发性。

滨下教授的主题报告后，世界非物质文化遗产泉州传统音乐南音的传承人蔡雅艺和陈思来夫妇应特邀为大会表演了南音。接下来王连茂先生以泉州南音为引线，就“福建闽南海外移民的文化角色”一题，探讨了闽南文化在海外的流播及闽南移民的作用。

接下来一天半的各个分科组的报告内容几乎涉及了华侨华人研究的所有领域，在这里谨从中选取几个侧面做一简介。

1. 侨乡研究与原乡研究。李明欢教授为主的一共有三个分科组14篇论文围绕着侨乡展开。这些论文以侨乡历史建构、社会治理、文化习俗、侨批侨刊乡讯、归侨安置沿革、侨乡跨国网络、当代侨乡变迁等7个层面对侨乡进行了解读。与侨乡研究相对，陈志明教授主持的分科组以“移民与家国：定居、谋生与家园重建”为题的四篇论文，则从神户华侨基督徒、胡志明市明乡家庭、广东华侨农场与柬埔寨华人社团等个案，讨论了原乡的变迁、重建及认同的多重性问题。

2. 日本华侨华人研究。长崎华商泰益号后裔陈东华作了“近代长崎华商网络”、四海楼当代家主陈优继作了“长崎华侨社会的历史和现状”、长崎市灯会执行委员会秘书长林敏幸作了“与地域一体化的长崎华侨”的报告。由这几位移民日本第4-5代的华侨后裔所作的这组特别讲演，也是一部难得的日本老华侨的自我认识史。

3. 新移民研究。新移民研究仍然是关注的焦点之一。周敏、Lu yixi、李唯三位教授以北美为案例，考察了高科技、知识性人才移民在资本与劳动力市场中的多重选择性，尤其是家庭、社区与文化背景在其中所具有的意义。Irene Masdeu Torruella考察了近年由西班牙回到中国的年青一代如何运用其经验与社会资本在西班牙和中国之间从事创新企业及专业活动。Qian Lifeng考察了新加坡优先政策对新移民的影响。王维教授则对日本东北人的移居背景、现状和社会结构进行了探讨。钱江教授等人分别对俄罗斯远东地区的新移民的经商、留学、社团、回流以及边贸等状况进行了研究。廖赤阳教授则提出了“后新移民”（后新华侨）的概念，其具体包括两个结构性变化：1）移民新秩序已经成为新常态；2）中国崛起对所产生的全方位影响。而“后”字则意味着持续与变化。

4. 边缘与跨界：女性、文学、“残孤”与“少数民族”

Yuma Ando、Florence Lévy、Ya-han Chuang三位学者、分别对柬埔寨移居法国的华人儿童、留法华北移民家庭的母子关系、以及华人妇女融入法国社会等个案进行了考察。赛汉卓娜教授通过对在日和日本丈夫结婚的中国女性就业的研究，发现这种国际婚姻不仅没有带来国际化与多元化，相反，成为延续保守的日本近代家庭形态残渣余孽的载体。南诚教授考察了1970年代以后回到日本的中国残留日本人及其家属，阐述了中国归国者的历史形成及其身份认同，并探讨其界限文化的意义。

舂谷锐教授主持的分科组的三篇论文，分别讨论了马华文学、菲华文学和日华文学的个案。林芳玫教授通过对台湾卑南族作家巴代的历史小说《最后的女王》，分析了番社、本土化汉人、大清帝国、荷兰人与日本人各种势力交错下变化的原汉关系。陈芷凡教授则通过对金门侨乡文学的反思，从原乡关系、移民海外、华语文学等角度将冷战时期的金门定位相对化。

另外，陈志明教授主持的另一分科组分别对中亚、南亚和东南亚的回族、藏族、哈萨克及东干等少数民族华侨华人在不同国家和地区的生活实践以及认同和归属等进行了探讨和分析。陈教授也主持了一组有关饮食与海外华人研究的讨论。

在大会闭幕式上，王赓武教授作了ISSCO25周年特别演讲并指出：20世纪初，在中国面临危机之际，海外华侨以前所未有的方式救亡中国，海外华人变成了一个非常政治化国家化的概念。1945年以后，新的民族国家世界秩序开始形成，华侨华人的概念也经历一个非政治化或非国家化的时期。这一时期的民族主义与冷战都与华人和中国有关，1980年代中国的改革开放，使世界发生了新的变化，海外华人为中国的经济发展发挥了重要的作用，海外华人研究开始成为学术界的新的关注焦点。1980年代末起，新的移民开始再次离开中国，这是自20世纪30年代以来的第一次大规模的迁移。它代表了一种完全不同的移民。受过良好教育的人的迁移，拥有很高水平的专业技能的人的迁移，资本和冒险的人的迁移，这是前所未有的。

赓武教授回顾了ISSCO25周年的历程，认为华人可以继续帮助中国，不是用金钱、投资，而是用思维 and 知识。这便意味着ISSCO仍然可以继续发挥自己的作用。

***The Ties that Bind: The Saga of the Sultan of Sulu in China*** by Teresita Ang See was launched in June 2017 in commemoration of the 600th year of the 1417 tribute mission of Sulu Sultan Paduka Batara to Ming Emperor Yong Le's court. The book contains the saga of the Sultan's royal visit, his death in Dezhou, Shandong on his way back to Sulu, his imperial burial and how his wife, second and third sons stayed to take care of the royal tomb, now a heritage park. Twenty-three generations of his descendants acknowledge their origins and ties with the Sulu people. The book's last part documents how after 588 years, the descendants of the second and third sons visited their lao jia in 2005. (Kaisa Para Sa Kaunlaran Inc., 2017. ISBN 978-971-8857-40-3)



***The Chinese in the Philippines, Problems and Perspectives***, vol. 5 (460 pages), contains a collection of conference and research papers presented by the author, Teresita Ang See, in local and international conferences and fora. Among the topics covered in eight chapters (with six short essays on Chinese Filipino concerns) are articles on cultural transformation and indigenization, religious syncretism, Chinese culture, new research on Chinese overseas and the Chinese in the Philippines.
